Fines

- You will not be charged overdue fines, but your account will be blocked when items are 10 days overdue.
- Accounts will be unblocked when items are returned in good condition.
- Fines for lost/damaged items will remain on your account.
- ELCL will continue to charge overdue fines for special collections.

*Because of the limited number of items in certain special collections & their cost & popularity, there will still be an overdue fine assessed to these materials: Gizmos & Gadgets; Ready, Set, Read Kits; Tools for School; Launchpads; & Mobile HotSpots.

Holds

Cardholders can request up to 25 items to be reserved. Items will be held for 7 days.

Loan Limits

Cardholders are limited to the following amount per visit, per card:

- 25 DVDs and 25 Blu-rays
- 2 ReadBox DVDs; 2 ReadBox Books
- 5 Interlibrary Loans (ILL) and 5 Electronic Games
- 25 Audiobooks and 25 Music CDs
- 50 Books and 50 Magazines
- 2 different Gizmos and Gadgets
- 2 different Museum Passes

Renewals

As long as an item is not being held for other patrons, all materials (except ReadBox Items, ILLs, & Mobile Hotspots) can be renewed a maximum of 3 times. DVDs & Blu-rays can be renewed once. This can be done in ELCL, by phone, or online through the Library's homepage in your patron account.

Adult Status

Anyone over 16 years of age with a valid Driver's License with Pinellas county address will receive an adult library card and is subject to the "Patron Confidentiality" section of ELCL's "Policies and Procedures"

Juveniles

Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian with a valid photo ID to receive a card.

You can use your library card at any Pinellas Public Library Cooperative (PPLC) library! You may also return your PPLC items to any PPLC library!

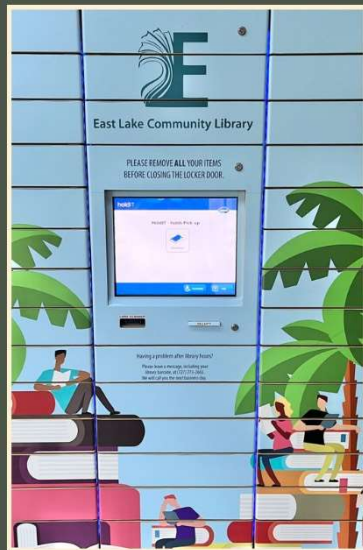

Who qualifies for free home delivery service?

- East Lake residents who live in the East Lake Community Fire District with a temporary/permanent condition that restricts mobility.

What materials can be delivered?

- Regular/large print, audio books, graphic novels, paperbacks, DVD's, or magazines owned by East Lake Community Library.

How does home delivery work?

- Obtain a library card if you don't already have one.
- Return completed Home Delivery Service Application.
- Complete a phone interview to determine eligibility & need (we will contact you).
- We offer bi-monthly deliveries.
- Return previously checked out times when your new delivery arrives.

We process the form DS-11: Application for New Passport. We do not process Passport Renewals, but we can provide form and photos. We work by appointment so book one today at eastlakelibrary.com/passports. If we are booked, come on Thursdays for walk-ins!

Thursdays are for Walk-Ins. 12:30pm - 3:30pm

Walk-Ins are first come, first served. Passport agents can answer questions, take photos, or process your application if you are fully prepared. Not prepared? Allow us to help!

Things to Remember

Our office is only permitted to process DS-11 forms. Library processing is \$35 and photos are \$10. You can pay us by cash, check or card. Passport Application fees vary on need, and **MUST** be paid by check to the "US DEPT OF STATE."

Each PPLC member library and its branches have 2 physical passes available to check out at a time. Passes are valid for use for up to 2 adults and 3 minors in a household.

Pass checkout
restricted to 18+
cardholders only



Important Info:

- Valid for a week after checking out
- Check out slip must be shown to admission staff upon entry
- Passes limited to a first come, first serve basis- and they are not renewable

Mobile Printing

Black & White - \$0.20/page Color - \$0.75/page
(coins and \$1 bills only)

When at the library, simply connect to the Library WiFi to print to the Library Printer.
When anywhere else, you can email documents to print and come to the library computer area **within 48 hours** to print your documents by entering your email address.

How to print at the library:

- **MOBILE:** Connect to the Library WiFi. Open the document or whatever you want to print, tap the share button, tap Print, then select Library Printer. Adjust settings such as color in the print preview then tap print. Pick up your print job at the front desk.

or smartphone*

- **LAPTOP:** Connect to the Library WiFi. Open your document or whatever you want to print, then go to menu>print or press **CTRL+P**. From the printer drop down menu, click add a printer to open the printer settings. Click +Add A Printer and select "Library Printer" (you may need to click "Show WiFi Direct Printers" for it to appear). Adjust settings such as color in the print preview then click print. Pick up your print job at the front desk.

How to print to the library from anywhere:

- You can print documents, pdfs, and photos by attaching them to an email and sending them to the following addresses:
- Black & white: **eastlake-bw@printspots.com**
- Color: **eastlake-color@printspots.com**
- Go to the East Lake Library and go to the Public Computer area.
- At the Print Release Station computer, click "Release a Print Job." on the computer screen.
- Enter the email address you used. Select your print job or jobs, click preview to double check them, then click "Print", then click "Pay from vending device". Insert coins or \$1 bills, then click OK. Your print job will now be printed!
- NOTE: In the list of print jobs, the system will separate attached documents from the email, so you don't need to print the empty email body if you just want the document.
